Committee Reports:

Lake Management Report

- Swamp oak growing on eastern shoreline, 30 feet from Westman Beach.
- Discussion on graphic projection board to supplement bulletin board, similar to what is on I&M Canal Trail.
- Oxygen levels in lake are good, some algae but dissipating, good underwater plants, visibility good.
- Invoice was sent to DuPage County for plants purchased as part of the grant, news release was sent out by DuPage County, one requirement of grant is to educate public on flowers and so Ken will write some articles for the Oak Leaf.
- Directions for access to the eastern shoreline will be included on bulletin board, should also be included in directory and new member packets.
- Kent sent several invoiced for Lynette, TJs and for two new tubeless tires for the cart.
- Resident offered to remove and trim bottom branches of tree on beach.
- Ken mentioned that lily pads were put into lake several times, but did not take and can be invasive. Can look into trying to put some in lake gain.

Landscape Report

- Cul-de-sac flowers doing well, John Yeater sent Jason an article on certifying the cul-de-sac, researching what this means.
- Jason tried a new annual flower at the entrances, but has needed more water than thought.
- Grass that was growing on the beach was pulled.
- Lilac bush to be planted where juniper bushes were removed.
- Cobblestones were placed near inlet by beach, Jason will pick up some bigger rocks to place on cobblestones to try and prevent people from throwing the stones into the lake.
- Jason will work on article for Oak Leaf on cul-de-sac, possibly also work on articles on lawn care.

Social Report

- No plans at this time for other social events, will monitor COVID-19 and CDC guidelines.
- Halloween party would be the next even, possibly a parade as in the past.

Communications Report

- Oak Leaf and Directory to be out in September.
- Ken suggested an article on what the Co. is doing in terms of lake levels.
